Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:


**Every Thursday from 7:30 am to
Friday morning at 7:00 am**



- ⊕ If Rockford Public Schools are closed due to weather, Eucharistic Adoration will be cancelled.
- ⊕ There is no Eucharistic Adoration when a Holy Day or civil holiday falls on a Thursday or Friday.
- ⊕ Thanksgiving is always on Thursday so no Eucharistic adoration on that Thursday or Friday.
- ⊕ On Holy Thursday, Eucharistic Adoration begins after the 7:00 pm Mass and ends at 10:00 pm.
- ⊕ On Good Friday there is no Eucharistic Adoration.

“COME TO ME...”

Adoration is for anyone who wishes to come. You do not have to be Catholic and there are no special requirements, except a willingness to be quiet and respectful in the chapel.



For security, the Chapel door is accessed by a door chime. The bell switch is located on the right hand side of the door mounted on a brick wall.
